
Data Request Process

Data requestor could refer to an individual researcher or an organization requesting data.



If the contract is not signed or no response is received from the Data Requestor for 60 calendar days, the contract will be considered to have expired.

Contract signed

In parallel with the Data Sharing/Licencing Agreement:

• Tech Team prepare sample anonymised data for user testing.

Tech Team perform final anonymised data extract.

• Note: Tech Team may be involved earlier in the process, in parallel with screening, depending on the confidence that request will be approved and contract executed, based on enquiry stage conversations.

An invoice is issued and Data Requestor makes the payment based on agreed contractual terms.
